The curriculum consists of procedural programming and web programming fundamentals in Python, with additional job-ready skills taught in Java or C#.

- Supports the Lead Instructor in delivering course content
- Helps the Lead Instructor in administering the course, including grading and attendance
- Works one-on-one with every student in the class to ensure optimal support and learning
