You will plan and deliver lectures, provide direction and oversight to TAs, and have final say on what happens during each class session. You will also be the primary liaison with LaunchCode staff, communicating feedback and any changes you plan to make.

Qualifications

- Ability to empathize and work with learners from a wide variety of backgrounds and skill levels
- Strong communication skills

- Proficiency in topics covered (e.g. a Java instructor should at least be comfortable with a statically-typed OO language)
- Willingness to learn in-depth the topics they are less familiar with
- General alignment with LaunchCode's educational philosophy
- Ability to lead and coach Teaching Assistants

The instructor can expect to work approximately 10 - 12 hours per week.
