#### **Position Type**

Part Time - Contract

This is a contracted, part-time, paid position. The class will run for 22 weeks, beginning Monday, October 7, 2019, and running through Monday, March 16. The class will meet Mondays & Wednesdays from 6:00-9pm at Rockhurst University.

Teaching Fellows will be paid \$12.50/hr and will work 6-8 hours a week. As contractors TFs are not eligible for employee benefits.

Teaching Fellows will also have the possibility to extend the contract for an additional 9-weeks from Monday, April 6 to Monday, June 8, for LaunchCode's professional development oriented Liftoff program.
