LaunchCode's Immersive CodeCamp:

CodeCamp is 15-17 weeks long, with class sizes between 30 and 40 students. Curriculum is managed by LaunchCode and delivered by course staff, which consists of one Lead Instructor and 1-2 Teaching Assistants. The curriculum consists of coding and web fundamentals in JavaScript, with additional job-ready skills taught in C# and Azure.

LaunchCode is seeking highly motivated individuals to serve as Teaching Assistants (TAs) for CodeCamp. TAs are responsible for assisting with instruction, working closely with students, and helping with course administration.

This is a full-time, contract position. The period of engagement is April 2020 through July 2020.

This position is located in the Washington D.C. Metropolitan Area.
