The curriculum consists of coding and web fundamentals in C#, DevOps training in Azure, additional job-ready skills taught in Python, and Data Structures & Algorithms.

LaunchCode is seeking a highly motivated person who will serve as the Lead Instructor for this project with a class size of approximately 30-40 students. The Lead Instructor will be responsible for executing curriculum, instructing students, and assisting students through the coursework with the help of multiple teaching assistants.

This is a full-time, remote contract position. The contract will begin May 24, 2021, running approximately 19 weeks including a preparation week and the full duration of the course.

- Works with LaunchCode staff to manage student enrollment and learning status, and regularly report course and student progress.

- A solid knowledge on current programming trends and best practices
- Building and deploying software applications from scratch
